This results in Chris and Peter finding out about Rosa's and her family's suspicious past, which is soon followed by a kidnapping and desperation by the main characters to keep everyone safe. May God use it to help you see and serve Jesus Christ as the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29). The divine commands to annihilate the seven nations living in Canaan (to 'devote them to destruction', herem in Biblical Hebrew) are perhaps the most morally troubling texts of the Hebrew and Christian bibles. Making Sense of Old Testament Genocide: Christian Interpretations of Herem Passages addresses the challenges these texts pose. It presents the various ways in which interpreters from the first century to the twenty-first have attempted to make sense of them. The most troubling approach was no doubt to read them as divine sanction and inspiration for violence and war: the analysis of the use of herem texts in the crusades, the inquisition, and various colonial conquests illustrates this violent way of reading the texts, which has such alarming contemporary relevance.
