They would have to study the makeup of hippo milk for the first time ever and reach out to medical colleagues, including a team at the local Children's Hospital with superior vein-finding skills, to ensure that Fiona would begin to gain weight and become healthy. This study was designed to determine if live animal contact during the Komodo Dragon Wild Discover Zone (KDWDZ) program at the Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Garden (CZBG) effectively increased zoo visitors' commitment to conservation. Conservation commitment was measured following the KDWDZ visit. Half of the programs utilized live reptiles, which the visitors were able to touch, while the other half of the programs did not utilize animal contact. Conservation commitment was

measured via the percentage of visitors who voluntarily submitted petitions and pledges. Descriptive statistics were analyzed to determine differences in visitor conservation commitment. Findings indicated no significant difference in pledges and petitions received. Factors leading to results are discussed along with implications for conservation education.
