There is hardly any country in the world that

has been immune to corruption scandals involving ruling political parties. Their collective will to power and lack of fear of possible consequences of their acts, makes it difficult to discipline them. Until now countries did not find a way to adequately address the criminal responsibility of political parties. The presented judgment in the Croatian CDU case is a precedent that can be used as a new model to address responsibility of political parties for economic crimes. Challenges that political corruption poses for society and democracy are large- scale, however, this new model also brings more challenges for democracy. This does not mean we should give up or substantially limit the criminal responsibility of political parties. Certain safeguards are already provided by obstacles in investigating, prosecuting, convicting and punishing political parties for criminal offences, such as e.g. immunity, abolition, amnesty, pardon, law amendments etc. However, it is necessary to determinate the correct balance in the spectrum of their application in order not to lead to a condition of irresponsible political structures. After evaluating certain sanctions that can be imposed on political parties, it seems that a fine is the most acceptable punishment for political parties in cases of economic crimes. Sanction of dissolution is generally considered to be inappropriate for political parties and especially too harsh for economic crimes. Some national legal systems tend to generally exempt political parties from this sanction, as it is the case in Croatia. The reason for this is to avoid possible threats of criminal proceedings to democracy, in which a ruling political party could use criminal prosecutions to exert pressure on or even eliminate opposition parties. Confiscation and compensation are sanctions of crucial importance in order to satisfy the principle that crime doesn't pay. Criminal procedure is an appropriate forum to resolve the issues arising from the illegally obtained assets from crimes committed by political parties, because civil proceedings completely depend on the initiatives of the damaged persons.

What determines the number of political parties in a democracy? Electoral rules certainly influence the incentives to create and maintain parties. However, a society's political culture can maintain parties despite electoral rules that give them poor prospects of success. Thus, comparing the number of parties and differences in electoral rules across countries cannot clearly test the effect of the electoral rules. A better test would examine a society with a fairly continuous political culture, but a change in electoral rules. Postwar France is such a society. While the basic social order has not changed, there was a drastic change in the electoral system in 1958, which theory implies would reduce the number of parties. Thus we can test the hypothesis that the number of parties fell with the change in electoral system. We can also calculate an "equivalent number of parties" to see how closely France approached a two-party system under the new regime. The first section describes the electoral rules under the Fourth and Fifth Republics. The second section develops a model that indicates how the change in electoral rules should have affected the incentives for multiple parties. The third section tests the hypothesis that the number of parties fell from the Fourth to the Fifth Republic.

1. Electoral Rules In the French Fourth Republic (1945 - 1958) political parties existed largely to serve the direct interests of their members. This book examines the process of presidentialisation of political parties in the Western Balkans. The Western Balkan countries deserve to be analysed in a comparative perspective due to their distinctive features in terms of processes of democratization, forms of government and institutional assets, the presence of social cleavages (religious, linguistic, ethnic), and, of course, the nature of political parties which differs from other European cases, especially in terms of origins, organization and structure. However, Western Balkan political parties do show certain similarities with other West European cases where power is centralised and held by the parties' leadership. The book ultimately attempts to test whether and to what extent the influence of institutional variables affects the level of presidentialisation of political parties, also considering the parties' organization features.

In *Political Parties, Business Groups, and Corruption in Developing Countries*, Vineeta Yadav examines corruption levels in sixty-four developing democracies over a twenty-year period, with a comparative focus on Brazil and India. Political party organizations play

large roles in democracies, yet their organizations differ widely, and their statutes change much more frequently than constitutions or electoral laws. How do these differences, and these frequent changes, affect the operation of democracy? This book seeks to answer these questions by presenting a comprehensive overview of the state of party organization in nineteen contemporary democracies. Using a unique new data collection, the book's chapters test propositions about the reasons for variation and similarities across party organizations. They find more evidence of within-country similarity than of cross-national patterns based on party ideology. After exploring parties' organizational differences, the remaining chapters investigate the impact of these differences. The volume considers a wide range of theories about how party organization may affect political life, including the impact of party rules on the selection of female candidates, the links between party decision processes and the stability of party programmes, the connection between party finance sources and public trust in political parties, and whether the strength of parties' extra-parliamentary organization affects the behaviour of their elected legislators. Collectively these chapters help to advance comparative studies of elections and representation by inserting party institutions and party agency more firmly into the centre of such studies.
