birds and 150 species of butterflies what are the different layers of a rainforest called web the rainforests of the wet tropics the daintree is home to the idiot fruit also known as the green dinosaur one of the world s rarest and oldest flowering plants where the daintree rainforest sits between cairns and cooktown in the north of queensland the world s oldest rainforest the daintree is so beautiful and lush that it was web 19 nov 2020 the amazon rainforest is the earth s most massive tropical rainforest the forest spans through the basin of the previously mentioned amazon river which itself is the world s second longest river and houses about 20 of the planet s plants and birds with 10 of mammal types found there the amazon rainforest is the world s largest rainforest web the rainforest was once a well used resource providing timber charcoal and tannin for tanning leather but our rainforest is threatened it has suffered long term declines through clearances chronic overgrazing and conversion to other uses this has left a small and fragmented resource web 3 feb 2016 daintree rainforest grows right down to the beach australia s daintree rainforest is a tropical rainforest located in the north of queensland this beautiful area is unusual in that the rainforest comes right down to the sea many of australia s famous animals live here including platypuses echidnas bandicoots and kangaroos web 1 mar 2023 rainforests are earth s oldest living ecosystems with some

treatment of rainforests follows for web 28 jul 2018 a rainforest consists of two major areas the very top part is called the canopy which can be as tall as 98 feet to 164 feet 30 to 50 meters this area is comprised of the tops of trees and web rainforests are home to over half of the world s plant and animal species learn about tropical and temperate rainforests how they contribute to the global ecosystem and the conservation efforts web 4 layers of the rainforest layers of the rainforest 1 emergent layer the emergent layer is the top layer of the rainforest it is over 45m 150 ft from the ground and in some areas trees can reach a height of over 70m 230 ft it is windy and wet in the rainforest s top layer due to the lack of shelter web as tropical rainforests are located on or close to the equator the climate is typically warm and wet the high rainfall and year round high temperatures are ideal conditions for vegetation growth the wide range of plants encourages a huge variety of insects birds and animals temperatures in the tropical rainforest are high throughout the year web 14 feb 2019 the elephant beetle is a large rainforest insect found in central and south america it is a member of the scarab beetle subfamily dynastinae a group of insects also known as rhinoceros beetles elephant beetles can grow up to around 12 cm 4 75 in with males reaching significantly larger sizes than females web 24 oct 2017 the large leaves of some plants can serve as containers if you have none vines are also

rainforest include living things i.e. the plants and animals to be precise the abiotic factors include precipitation sunlight temperature and so on web rainforests are essential to life on earth not only do they provide air water medicine food and shelter for people and animals they are also one of our best natural defenses against the climate crisis due to their role in the carbon cycle we've curated some facts about rainforest and its inhabitants for you to share with friends use web rainforests are defined as dense forests with high amounts of annual rainfall that are often located in tropical regions there are two types of rainforest tropical and temperate tropical rainforests are often located between the tropic of capricorn and the tropic of cancer they are generally warm and humid year round web rainforest temperature the rainforest biome remains warm all year and must stay frost free the average daily temperatures range precipitation rainforests receive the most rain of all of the biomes in a year a typical year sees 2 000 to 10 000 vegetation location other there are two web 16 aug 2017 rainforests as you might guess are forests that receive a great amount of rainfall more than 80 inches each year composed of millions of unique ecosystems rainforests are the central nervous system of our planet a hotbed web 11 mar 2020 the understory the rainforest's dark basement shelter one layer up from the forest floor is the understory here light is at a premium the thick vegetation
