Results can last years, depending on your skin type and sun exposure.

Chemical peel: a chemical peel also treats wrinkly under-eye skin by removing superficial top layers.

Eye muscle surgery: is an outpatient procedure. Local anesthesia or general anesthesia can be used for pain control. Sometimes more than one surgery is needed, and each procedure may be scheduled at a separate time.

Oculoplastic surgery: is a general term used to represent a variety of procedures that involve the orbit, eyelids, tear ducts, and the face. Ocular reconstructive surgery, aesthetic eyelid surgery, facial plastic surgery, and cosmetic procedures fall into this category. Some types of oculoplastic surgery are considered both medically necessary and cosmetic.
